Once again MOS put up a great display at the Marin County Fair. We had 66 plants ... which may not sound like a lot but the quality was absolutely stunning. Thanks to all who volunteered plants and who helped with the setup. We added a large monitor that improved the experience by adding a better visual aspect to the presentations (no more passing around laminated photos).

I'm glad the Fair is over. Between the July 4th party and the Fair, it's been an exhausting few week, visiting the Southern California kids, planning for both

the July 4th party and the Fair display, and revamping my Fair presentation. I look forward to relaxing!

I was down in SoCal for Evelyn's birthday. That was a whirlwind trip with two birthday parties as well as Evelyn's swim class. One of the birthday parties was at an indoor trampoline park. The amount of energy expended there is astounding. If that energy could be harnessed a small town could have air conditioning for a full year.

My greenhouse is doing well. I contributed 6 plants to the Fair display including fragrant plants. The place needs cleaning from strong afternoon winds blowing leaves in under walls of my greenhouse. A corkscrew willow is constantly dropping leaves and small branches. My trying to keep the yard clean is a losing proposition.

I do need to add an automated watering and misting system due to rising temperatures to cool the plants. Plus an improved ventilation. system. There is a fan inside the greenhouse. I'm considering moving it outside with a vent under the wall for fresher air circulation and freeing up more space.

July 23 - Speaker: Carlos Lopez Habenarias and their Hybrids



Our July speaker is Carlos Lopez from Sunset Valley Orchids - a delightful, engaging speaker.

About Carlos:

Jose Carlos Lopez is a Business student at MiraCosta college who has been cultivating orchids for over 12 years. His orchid venture began at the age of thirteen years old when he started to follow his father to work at Sunset Valley Orchids. Before he knew it, he was volunteering at the nursery and was helping clean orchid flasks, repot orchids, and doing small tasks. Carlos eventually began to become more involved in the nursery's operations/maintenance and started to take part in attending orchid shows. He is currently Sunset Valley Orchids Greenhouse specialist and has years of experience with *Cattleya, Catasetum, Australian Dendrobiums*, and *Sarcochilus*. Carlo is currently training to become an accredited American Orchid Society Judge and works with Orchid Digest as well.

Habenarias and their Hybrids:

How did he get started with *Habenaria*? We'll have to wait for the full story, but it seems Carlos saw one, was intrigued, and wondered if he could grow it. The experiment was a success. He wil review the species and hybrids from this class of orchids and discuss cultural tips, care and how to grow them for these unusual and beautiful terrestrials.

This month's plan table will consist of orchids from Carlos collection and from Sunset Valley Orchids.

Editor's Note: I house sat in Solano County last July and attended the San Diego Orchid Society meeting where Carlos spoke on Habanerias and indeed got me excited about this unusual plant. Luckily, Peter T. Lin of Diamond Orchids was speaking the following week at the Palomar Orchid Society me and brought a *Habaneria pegasus* for me from his greenhouse. (see image below). June Speaker, Dave Sorokowsky Don't Fear the Slippers - Paphiopedilums




Dave helped dispel *paph* cultivating anxieties with his educational and visually spectacular presentation. Some points:

- 1. Water THOROUGHLY up and down and from four angles in early morning
- 2. Favored potting medium Orchiata New Zealand pine bark add 30% No. 3 perlite and 20% charcoal (occasionally add oyster shells).
- 3. MSU fertilizer
- 4. Repot annually

Marin County Fair, July 3-7, 2024 - another Success reported by Ron Ludwig



Marin Orchid Society presented a spectacular display of 66 plants, all of them dazzling. Among the 66 were 16 fragrant plants. The wide variety of plants as well as the rainbow of colors captured attendees. Many oohed and aahed the plants. The fragrant plants were a big draw - many thought orchids had no fragrance. MOS had 2 presentations scheduled each day. Barbara Herod was kind enough to do the one presentation on the 4th. The first two presentations of the week, were heavily attended. However, the 1pm presentations on Thursday through Saturday were empty. The reason may have been that Wednesday was Senior Day while the other days were more like family days where the kids were more interested in the rides outdoors. The 3pm talks were generally better attended.

Our hands-on area, which was a huge hit last year, did not draw the same crowds although the vanilla tasting was popular. As vanilla and vanilla orchid were part of my presentation, that added to the draw. We had a lot of people ask questions. Virtually all were either: How do I grow *phalaenopsis* (or "I have a white orchid ..."), How do I get *phalaenopsis* to reflower, or "Why does my *phalaenopsis* have all these roots sticking out". Of course, those who attended my talks, I eliminated the belief in watering with ice cubes!

This year we added a hands-on repotting demonstration. Lynne and Susan provided 12 *Phals* as source plants for repotting. I also had 25 donation plants from Chris Hamilton. The repotting demos were a HUGE success. I had planned only one demo per day and only 6 plants per demo but ended up adding a second demo for the last 3 days. Starting with Friday I brought in an

extra flat of plants each day. Each demo had at least double the attendees as there were available plants. For the last demo on Sunday, I had to turn away several people because I ran out of plants. There were also three layers of people looking over the shoulders of the ones in front.
