September 24 - Speaker: Ken Jacobsen Growing Specimen and Large Orchids



Ken was first introduced to orchids by his uncle in the 1960's and has been growing orchids for well over 50 years. His collection includes lots of *Cattleyas* and *Laelias*, *Cymbidiums*, *Oncidiums*, *Odontoglossums*, *Lycastes*, *Masdevallias*, and other genera. Ken and his wife, Amy, enjoy travelling to all areas of the world where orchids are grown, visiting the local growers, and seeing various species in the wild. Together, Amy and Ken have over 5000 orchids, not counting seedlings (and there are a lot of seedlings!).

Ken is a judge in the AOS judging program, was a judge in the CSA judging program, and is a past AOS trustee.
