

September Speaker, Ken Jacobsen Growing Specimen and Large Orchids



Ken clarified - What is the difference between a Specimen Orchid and. a Large Display Orchid? A Specimen according to the American Orchid Society judging standards must be all one rhizome (not multiple pieces). A Large Display Orchid is made up of multiple pieces of the same plant.


