

He has grown them outside, in greenhouses and under lights, and has won over 10 AOS quality awards.

His presentation to start off the new year is entitled "Throw out the bark for the last time and never repot again: several inorganic options." This includes use of various media, containers and methods (including semi hydroponic) based on his recent experiments and experiences.

The Marin Orchid Society at its recent Board meeting, approved a donation to the Orchid Conservation Alliance. The Alliance "partners with organizations and foundations in orchid rich regions to protect the native habitats of orchids. Creating reserves, preserves numerous orchid species, often including undiscovered forms as well as the ecosystems in which they exist. Critical for orchid conservation in the wild, <u>preservation of habitat</u> protects pollinators as well as birds, amphibians, mammals, other plants."
